Applicability

This policy mandatorily applies to all CoA Employees, Contractors and Third Parties working within a relevant contract, except where a variation has been agreed due to local legislation or custom.

The following environmental aspects of CoA's operations have been identified as significant:

Consumption of energy – CoA is committed to minimising its consumption of non-renewable energy sources and to research alternative sources and technologies to reduce consumption of energy across all activities. In particular, CoA aims to manage its Operations to ensure that it meets continually improving energy performance standards.

Production of waste – CoA strives to minimise the waste it generates and the consequent environmental impacts by seeking opportunities to reduce, reuse, recycle and recover otherwise redundant resources.

Use of transport – CoA is aware of the environmental impacts of their transport operations and, through the use of sustainable transport and seeks ways to reduce transport impacts wherever practicable.

Use of resources – CoA works to ensure that the products, services and materials which it purchases are as sustainable as practical.
